Hauling Guide



Step 1: Pack Strategically



Heavy Items Low and Forward

Heaviest items at the bottom and closest to the cab for better stability.

Fill the Gaps

Tuck smaller items into odd-shaped gaps to keep the entire load compact.



Balance the Weight

Keep weight even across the vehicle to prevent dangerous shifting during transit.

Step 2: Secure and Cover Every Load

Cover It or Lose It

Always use a tarp or net to keep loose items from flying out.

Secure in Every Direction

Ensure items are tied down from the front, back, sides, and top.



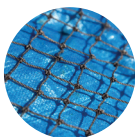
Equipment Guide

Heavy-Duty Ratchet Straps



For primary load security

Tarps & Cargo Nets



For loose or partial loads

Heavy-Duty Bungee Cords



For very lightweight items

Step 3: Drive with Care!

CAPACITY

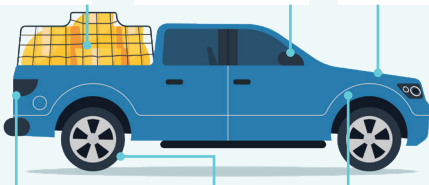
Know your limit and never overload.

MIRRORS

Adjust for optimal visibility around your load.

DRIVING

Increase stopping distance and navigate turns carefully.



LIGHTS

Verify all signals and brake lights work.

TIRES

Inflate properly to support the extra weight.

BRAKES

Check condition to handle longer stopping distances.
